Quizlet is a free website providing learning tools for students, including flashcards, study and game modes. It was created by high school sophomore Andrew Sutherland in 2005 and now contains over 400 million study sets. All of the material is user-generated.

How to use Quizlet

- Sign up**
 Go to quizlet.com and click on "Sign Up" on the upper right. You can also sign up with Google or Facebook. Pick a username and password. Enter your email address and birthday.
- Class**
 Find your class with a short link that the instructor provides in class. This is the easiest way to find the flashcard sets for your class.
- Study (Flashcards, Learn, and Test)**
 Track your progress with 6 powerful study and game modes! *Flashcards*—Review your material, shuffle/randomize, or listen with audio. *Learn*—Track your correct/incorrect answers and retest the ones you've missed. *Test*—Randomly generate tests based on your flashcard set.
- Live**
 Your instructor may use Quizlet Live during your class. It's a fun way to learn new terms and concepts with your classmates.
