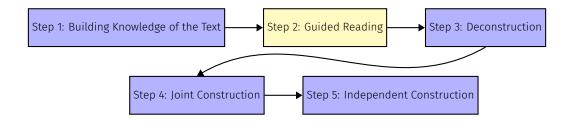

## SFL Writing Task & Homework 3

In the "Step 2: Guided Reading" phrase, the focus is on ensuring students grasp the model text's global meaning through structured class discussions, working with paragraphs to understand parts of the text, and completing activities that help summarize and conceptualize the content. The desired outcome is for students to see the text as a composite of different parts rather than a singular whole.



This week, we will focus on **register** of the writing project. According to Derewianka & Jones (2016), the register consists of the following three components:

- (1) The **field** refers to the subject matter or topic of the discourse. It can be anything from everyday conversation to a scientific paper. The field of a discourse will influence the choice of vocabulary, grammar, and other linguistic features.
- (2) The **tenor** refers to the relationship between the participants in the discourse. It can be formal or informal, intimate or distant. The tenor of a discourse will influence the choice of address forms, politeness strategies, and other linguistic features.
- (3) The **mode** refers to the purpose of the discourse. It can be informative, persuasive, or expressive. The mode of a discourse will influence the choice of rhetorical devices, argumentation strategies, and other linguistic features.

All genres can be defined in terms of fields, tenors, and modes. For example,

- (4) **Conversation**: Field: everyday topics; Tenor: informal, intimate; Mode: expressive
- (5) News article: Field: current events; Tenor: formal, distant; Mode: informative
- (6) Scientific paper: Field: scientific research; Tenor: formal, distant; Mode: informative
- (7) **Persuasive essay**: Field: controversial topics; <u>Tenor</u>: formal, distant; <u>Mode</u>: persuasive
- (8) Poem: Field: human experience; Tenor: intimate, expressive; Mode: expressive

マクドナルドのファストフードは、世界中で愛されているものの、その美味しさに関しては批判も少なくありません。第一に、マクドナルドのバーガーは量産型の味わいがあり、特別なフレーバーや深みが欠けていると言えます。素材の質が全ての店舗で一定でないことも問題です。たとえば、パティは時として乾燥しているか、あるいは焼きすぎで硬すぎることがあります。また、使用される調味料やソースは一般的に塩分や糖分が高く、健康的とは言い難い味わいです。
